

- Notice of intent to protest must be given to the plate umpire prior to the next pitch in the game (except player eligibility protests).
- Protesting Manager is responsible for ensuring that both scorebooks are signed by the umpire for the protest to be considered valid.
- Written protest must be filed with the League Umpire-In-Chief (or Executive Board Member) within forty-eight (48) hours after game time and must be accompanied by a forty-dollar (\$40.00) protest fee, which is refundable if protest is upheld.
- Include photocopies of your scorebook; Visiting and Home
